CMDDA has committed to **Cdn.** \$ 200,000 towards this project which has an anticipated cost of approximately US \$ 1,000,000.

Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory Unit in the Northern Province when complete will add to the existing ten other units operating successfully in Sri Lanka.

Why?

With the increase in heart related casualties in the Northern Province, and the unstable political situation in the area, the urgency for an advanced Cardiac unit is greater than ever! Patients are re located to hospitals out of their province against their wishes, individuals who are unable to travel due to medical and/or economical reasons have no choice but, to receive secondary care in Jaffna, risking their health and ultimately their lives.

The Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka has committed towards the maintenance of the equipment, and has ensured the future needs of the patients in the Northern Province are met.
